Questions, Comments, and Responses

- Why are we so focused on solar instead of wind power?
 - The Comprehensive Plan process can address solar, wind, and other energy industries – it does not have to be focused on one or another.
- Why is the county planning department doing this plan for the town?
 - The County Planning Department is providing assistance to the Town to develop the Comprehensive Plan.
- Is the county going to push the town to do anything?
 - No, the County is just facilitating the process. All decisions about the content of the Comprehensive Plan will be made by the Town.
- How many surveys have come out and how will we have them ready for the meeting in January?
 - 34 surveys have been returned as of 12/14/21. The results of the survey will be presented at the public workshop on February 8. There will be a Steering Committee meeting in January to begin brainstorming the vision and goals of the Comprehensive Plan.
- What gives the plan teeth to go to court or fight something?
 - The teeth are the actions taken after the Comprehensive Plan is adopted to further the goals of the Comprehensive Plan. The Comprehensive Plan is a policy document, not a regulatory document.
- Is there any way going backwards? Does everything get grandfathered in?
 - The Town can amend the Comprehensive Plan after it's adopted the document is intended to be flexible and not binding.
- This is like a cookie cutter? All the towns will become a part of this plan?

- Comprehensive Plans are unique to their municipality and decisions for the content of each Comprehensive Plan are made locally.
- I have solar and geothermal. Most of my solar is on the roof, you can grow things underneath as long as they don't cover the panels.
 - Noted.
- Concerned that information from the surveys will be given away.
 - The surveys are anonymous and the information is just to be used for the Comprehensive Plan process.
- If we haven't had a plan until now why do we need one?
 - There is more interest now in the Town than there was in the past to explore land use guidance and structure. The Comprehensive Plan will provide that structure.
- How can property owners become more involved to make sure their voices are heard? Only heard about the plan from the survey sent to her house.
